Video Presentation: Israel: Appointment with Destiny

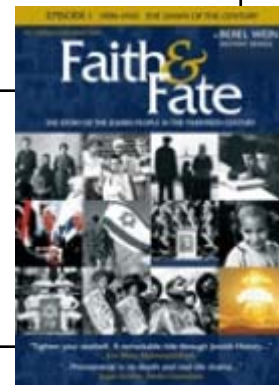
This stirring documentary dramatizes the history of Zionism and reveals the sad history of the Christian denominations in persecuting the Jews.



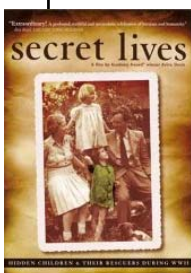
