## Parashas Vayeshev– 5771 –

Near the beginning of Parashas Vayeshev, we find, “These are the generations of Yaakov – Yoseph...” (Bereshis 37:2) Rashi cites a Midrash, which mentions a number of reasons for this unusual construction:

- 1) The main reason that Yaakov labored at Lavan’s house was his love of Rachel, the mother of Yoseph.
- 2) Yaakov and Yoseph were essentially identical in appearance.
- 3) Everything experienced by Yaakov was experienced by Yoseph; for example, they were both hated by their siblings, to the extent that the sibling wanted to kill them.

Another similarity not mentioned in the Midrash was that both Yaakov and Yoseph were dreamers. Yaakov experienced his most famous dream in Yerushalayim, in which HaShem spoke to him from the top of the ladder, “The land upon which you lie, I will give to you and to your descendants.” (Bereshis 28:13) In Vayeshev, Yoseph is the dreamer, and Yaakov feels an especially strong attachment to him. And, since love overcomes common sense, Yaakov openly displays his greater love for Yoseph by presenting him with a multi-colored coat. In Parashas Vayechi, just before Yaakov blesses his sons, the Midrash says that he wished to reveal to them what would occur at the “end of days,” which he knew by Prophecy, which, according to the Rambam, is always transmitted from HaShem to the Prophet (except in the case of Moshe) in a dream, but HaShem prevented him from doing so.

Yoseph’s brothers are aware of the greater love felt by their father towards Yoseph, which only adds to their hatred of their gifted younger brother. Yoseph dreams two prophetic dreams, the gist of which is his ascendance above his brothers, and in the second dream, of the heavenly bodies, above his parents as well.

What was Yoseph dreaming of? Clearly, he was dreaming of his rise to greatness in Mitzrayim, and his taking care of his People during their first Exile. But it is possible that he was also dreaming of the distant future, of the time of the redemption of his People from their final Exile. At that time, one of his descendants, through his near-future son, Ephraim, would become the Mashiach ben Yoseph, would rid the world of evil, and pave the way, along with Eliyahu HaNavi, for Mashiach ben David. It is possible that Yaakov, sensing the great import of Yoseph’s dreams, didn’t hesitate to send Yoseph to his brothers, although he was aware of the great danger that posed for Yoseph.

The Shem MiShmuel explains the function of the two Messiahs, the Mashiach ben Yoseph and the Mashiach ben David. That is, the Mashiach ben Yoseph will destroy the seed of Amalek, and he will conduct the final battle with the seed of Esav, for Esav will fall only by the hand of a son of Rachel, as it says in Midrash Rabbah. And as the external, so will it be with the spiritual, for from this perspective, both Meshichim are heart surgeons. Mashiach ben Yoseph will pull aside the curtain which separates the Heart of Israel, and he will tear away that which seals their Heart, and he will soften the Heart of Stone, after which will come Mashiach ben David, and he will find a Heart of Flesh, prepared and suitable to receive the great “Ki Tov” which he will pull down from Above. Thus, the nature of Mashiach ben Yoseph is, as it were, to mix metaphors, to plow the earth for Mashiach ben David.

Another perspective concerning the role of the two Meshichim, again seen in medical terms, is that the Mashiach ben Yoseph will be a spiritual neurologist-neurosurgeon, whose task will be to excise the “tumors” that have afflicted the “brain” of the Holy People, such that it could temporarily not distinguish between the Holy and the Impure. But Yoseph, who would be called a “first-born ox” (Devarim 33:17) by Moshe Rabbeinu, for he was an “ox” in Holiness, for he knew “konehu,” his Master. And Mashiach ben David will play the role of a cardiac surgeon, who will come to fix the diseased portions of our Heart, that it will never desire anything unworthy, and he will ride the “chamor” of Holiness, which is always humble and contrite, accepting the burden of the Kingdom of Heaven. And it desires and yearns only for Holiness, for that spirit epitomized David HaMelech, A”H, and it will epitomize Mashiach ben David, who will insert that type of Love into the Heart of Israel, as it says (Devarim 30:6) “And HaShem your G-d will circumcise your heart and the heart of your offspring, to love HaShem your G-d with all your Heart and with all your Soul, in order that you may live.”

Thus, without medical jargon, the roles of the two Meshichim will be as follows: Mashiach ben Yoseph will eliminate the seed of Amalek, and will fight the Wars of Gog and Magog, and all the wars will be fought and finished by him. His mission will be to remove the dark clouds which hide and block the G-dly Light. And after the removal of the hiddenness and the darkness, will shine the Light of Mashiach ben David, who will have no wars with non-Jews. Rather, his entire mission will be to bring the Knowledge of HaShem to earth.
