Parashas Vayekhel-Pikudei

The Building of the Mishkan and the Creation of the Universe

There are many parallels found between the building of the Mishkan and the creation of the universe. Near the end of Parashas Pekudei, and the completion of the Mishkan, in Shemos 39:27, we find, "And they made the tunics of , fine linen, of woven work, for Aharon and his sons." This is followed by immediately by "and the miter of , fine linen, and the elegant head coverings of , and the linen breeches of , of fine twined linen" (Shemos 39:28) – again followed immediately by "and the belt of , and blue and purple and scarlet yarn, the work of a weaver in colors, as the L-rd had commanded Moshe." (Shemos 39:29). It is possible that these five repetitions of the word , where meaning "fine linen," correspond to the homonym, number 6, as in , the Six Days of Creation that preceded the Great Seventh Day, the original , when HaShem rested.

The Torah then says, "All the work of the Mishkan, the Tent of Meeting, was completed, and the Children of Israel had done everything that HaShem commanded Moshe, so did they do." (Shemos 39:32) All the materials are brought to Moshe, who proceeds to erect the Mishkan and its courtyard; "He erected the courtyard all around the Mishkan and the altar, and he emplaced the curtain of the gate of the courtyard. So Moshe completed the work." (Shemos 39:33) And this corresponds to the verse finalizing the , "Thus the heaven and the earth were finished, and all their array. By the Seventh Day G-d completed His work which He had done, and He abstained on the Seventh Day from all the work which He had done. G-d blessed the Seventh Day and sanctified it because on it He abstained from all His work which G-d created to make." (Bereshis 2:1-2)

Sa'adya Gaon writes in his work, "Sefer Emunos Ve-Deos" as follows: "Lest a person be surprised by the work of the Mishkan, and say, why does the Creator need a Sanctuary and a Curtain, and Lamps burning and musical instruments and the offering of incense, and pleasant aroma, and Menachos Offerings from wheat, and wine and oil, and the first-fruit that was donated, we will attempt to explain, with the help of HaShem. He truly has no need for all the Service mentioned, for everything that we see proves that He has no need for anything, but rather everyone and everything needs Him, but the intention is that his servants should supply His request for the best of their possessions; namely, meat and wine and oil and incense and wheat and all pleasant things, and they should provide the best of their possessions as per their strength, so that He would provide for them on a greater scale according to His capability, as He says, "Honor HaShem with your possessions, with the 'first fruit' of all your possessions, and he will fill your storehouses and make your presses overflow with wine, and save you from injuries in a manner which no one beside Him can do"...and they should honor that "Light" which is called the 'Divine Presence' from their possessions of silver and gold and pearls and iron and other valuable things, and He will provide for you the Gift of Prophecy from that Place, as it says regarding the Mishkan, 'And I will make My Presence known there to the Children of Israel' and that will also be the place from which the prayers of the People will be heard and answered in regard to any trouble which may come upon them, as Shlomo prayed, and HaShem answered, 'I have heard the prayer and the plea which you have offered to Me.' " (Essay 3, Chapter 10)
