Parashas Devarim "Shabbos Chazon"- "Tit for Tat"

With regard to the bombing of a bus carrying Israeli tourists in Bulgaria, in which 7 innocent civilians were killed, a "senior American official" (quoted in the New York Times) said the attack was "tit for tat" retaliation by Iran for Israel's assassination of Iranian nuclear scientists. Among many who took issue with the characterization of a terror attack on Israeli tourists and the assassination of scientists working on an illicit nuclear program (the goal of which was the destruction of Israel) as morally equivalent, was John Bolton, former U.S. Ambassador to the U.N. He said, in paraphrase form: I think Israel is perfectly entitled to respond to the threat of massive destruction. Israel's act could be classified as pre-emptive self-defense, to dissuade Iran, if the leaders of that nation are capable of rational calculation, to back off from its course.

In "Sefer Tehilim," in one of the chapters recited in our "shul" in behalf of "Eretz Yisrael," we find the terror of dealing with an enemy who has no concept and no appreciation of Truth. *"Shir HaMa'alos to HaShem, in my distress I cried, and He answered me. HaShem, save my soul from language which is nothing but falsehood, from deceitful speech... Woe unto me, for my drawn-out sojourn; I dwelt with those who inhabit the tents of Kedar (Kedar is the Arab empire of Yishmael, the great power that would persecute Israel in exile) Long has my soul dwelt with those who hate peace. I long for peace, but when I speak, my opponent prepares for war." Tehilim (120 1-2, 5-7)*

The "Kerias Shema" Prayer, both morning and evening, concludes with the words, *"HaShem your G-d is True."* In the morning, following "Kerias Shema," we recite sixteen (including "True") Truth-related adjectives, "True and certain, established and enduring, fair and faithful, beloved and cherished, delightful and pleasant, awesome and powerful, correct and accepted, good and beautiful is this affirmation..." – expressing our gratitude to HaShem for rescuing us from the bondage of Mitzrayim, in ancient days.

With regard to the "Kerias Shema" of the evening, we recite "True and faithful is all this, and it is firmly established for us that He is HaShem, our G-d, and there is none but Him, and we are Israel, His nation. He redeems us from the power of kings; our King Who delivers us from the hand of all the cruel tyrants..." With this, we express our Faith that HaShem will ultimately redeem us from this long exile, as communicated to the True Prophets of Israel. And if a prophecy is made by a True Prophet of something favorable, such as **the Final Redemption**, there is no doubt that it **will come true**.

As we approach the Evening "Shemoneh Esray," we recite "Blessed is HaShem by day; Blessed is HaShem by night; Blessed is HaShem when we retire; Blessed is HaShem when we arise. For in Your hand are the souls of the living and the dead. He in Whose hand is the soul of all the living and the spirit of every human being. In Your hand I shall entrust my spirit; You redeemed me, HaShem, G-d of Truth..." And we conclude, "May our eyes see, our heart rejoice and our soul exult in **Your Salvation in Truth**, when Zion is told, 'Your G-d has reigned!'"
