## Parashas Vayetze Yishmael and Esav from a Long Perspective

"So far, we've seen in the weekly Torah Readings, the progeny of the first two of the Avos: Avraham and Yitzchak. In each case, there was extreme sibling rivalry: between Yishmael and Yitzchak and between Yaakov and Esav. Between Yishmael and Yitzchak, Yishmael's weapon of choice was mockery; in the Yaakov-Esav confrontation, Esav's threat was naked violence.

At the "Seudas Mitzvah" of Yitzchak's weaning, the Torah tells us,

"Sarah saw the son of Hagar, the Egyptian, whom she had borne to Avraham, mocking. So she said to Avraham, 'Drive out this slave-woman with her son, for the son of that slave-woman shall not inherit with my son, with Yitzchak!' " The matter greatly distressed Avraham regarding his son. The Almighty then said to Avraham, "Be not distressed over the youth or your slave-woman. Whatever Sarah tells you, heed her voice, since through Yitzchak will offspring be considered yours." (Bereshis 21:9-11)

"When Yitzchak and Rivkah have the twins Yaakov and Esav, the Torah tells us,

"The lads grew up and Esav became an accomplished hunter, a man of the field; but Yaakov was a gentle soul, dwelling in tents of study. Yitzchak loved Esav, for game was in his mouth, but Rivkah loved Yaakov." (Bereshis 25:27-28)

When Yitzchak became old, and was ready to transmit his blessing to his son, Yitzchak said to Esav,

"Now sharpen, if you please your hunting gear, your sword and your bow, and go out to the field and hunt game for me. Then make me delicacies such as I love... and I will eat, so that my soul will bless you before I die..." (Bereshis 27:3-4)

Rivkah proceeded to instruct Yaakov to pretend that he was Esav, and receive the blessing that was meant for his brother. When Esav learned of the deception, he was, to put it mildly, somewhat unhappy:

"He cried out with an exceedingly great and bitter cry and said to his father, 'Bless me too, Father!' ...Now Esav harbored hatred towards Yaakov...and Esav thought, 'May the days of mourning for my father draw near, and I will kill my brother, Yaakov.' " (Bereshis 27:34, 41)

Esav, the Roman Empire, and the Christian Church. harbored this hatred for more than three thousand years, and then something changed. David Brog has written an excellent book, called "Standing with Israel," in which he traces the effects of this hatred through pogroms, massacres, expulsions, even through the Holocaust and beyond. He shows how the verse "I will bless those who bless you, and him who curses you I will curse; and all the families of the earth shall bless themselves by you." (Bereshis 12:3), spoken by HaShem to Avraham, has been proven true over and over again. Except that now the majority of Christians have seen its truth, and support the Jewish People and the State of Israel, out of true feelings of respect and love. They have confessed their sins and have resolved wholeheartedly to "Stand with Israel."

And, as the events of the past week have shown, the only enemy (with the cease-fire, may we dare to hope that even this enmity is coming to an end?) who remain are the Arab Muslims, who have thus far stubbornly resisted the evidence before their eyes, of the continuous historical connection between the Jewish People and the Land of Israel, and of the truth of Bereshis 12:3!
