Parashas Terumah – Who Were the Donors?

(The content of this mini-essay is based on (it is actually a translation of...) a Dvar Torah written by Rav Shimon Schwab, ZT"l, among the others which he wrote on Parashas Terumah in "Ma'ayan Bais HaSho'evah")

"At the beginning of Parashas Terumah, we find HaShem speaking to Moshe Rabbeinu as follows: (*Shemos 25:2*) 'Speak to the Children of Israel, and let them take a donation for Me, from everyone whose heart so inclines him.' "

"Now the donation to the Mishkan came from the Children of Israel alone, as opposed to the case where Shlomo built the First Bais HaMikdash, with the assistance of Chiram King of Tzor and his associates, who did not come from the Children of Israel. The Second Bais HaMikdash followed the pattern of the Mishkan, as we find (*Ezra 4:3*) 'It is not for you, but rather for us, to build a House for our G-d; thus we see that they prevented other nations from joining in the construction. This matter requires explanation."

"It seems that the building of Shlomo was made in order to draw near all of humanity to the worship of HaShem as one nation, in accordance with the words of the prophet (regarding the Third Temple) *Yeshayahu (56:7)*, 'For My House will be a House of Prayer for all the nations;' and so we understand from the Inauguration Prayer of Shlomo HaMelech, that the construction of his Holy Temple was also intended for the sacrifices of all the nations, as it is written (*Melachim I, 8:41-42*) 'and also for the gentile who is not from Your nation Israel... that he should come and pray at this House.' For it was Shlomo's hope that the nations would flock to the Temple that he built, in accordance with the words of the prophets (see *Yeshayahu 2:2*) regarding the Third Temple at the Time of the Moshiach. And therefore he made ten Menoros and ten Sacred Tables, which hint at the large volume of Divine Worship he anticipated from the many nations who participated in its construction."

"Which was the opposite of the purpose of the Mishkan, which was to provide testimony for Israel as to the continuation of the Divine Presence among them, and its purpose was not for the sacrifices of all of humanity; therefore, it was constructed only from the donations of the People of Israel. And similarly in the Second Temple, which was built in an age when there was no king in Israel and no prophet; all understood that this Temple was exclusively for the spiritual growth of the People of Israel, as was the Mishkan of Moshe. And therefore they did not allow other nations to participate in its construction, and thus they made in the Second Temple only one Menorah and one Sacred Table, as in the prototype of the Mishkan."
