Parashas Ki Sisa – HaShem's Covenants

At the end of Parashas Mishpatim, we find a reference to the “Sefer HaBris,” the Book of the Covenant: “And he took the Book of the Covenant, and he read it to the people, and they said, ‘Everything that HaShem has spoken, we will do and try to comprehend.’” (Shemos 24:7) Rashi defines the Book of the Covenant as material from Bereshis till the Giving of the Torah and the Commands which were given at Marah. (Mechilta 19:10) From this definition, we can infer that this expression refers to an early Covenant,

At the end of Parashas Ki-Sisa, before Moshe receives the second set of “luchos,” and after HaShem reveals to him the Thirteen Divine Attributes (Shemos 34:6-7), we find the following: “And He said, ‘Behold I will establish a Covenant; regarding your entire People. I will perform wonders which have not existed in all the Land and among all the nations, and the entire nation of which you are a part, will see the work of HaShem, for it is awesome, that which I do for you.’” (Shemos 34:10)

But that is only the first part of the Covenant; miracles will be performed if and only if the People of Israel fulfills its side of the Covenant:

The next sixteen verses contain a variety of commands based obviously on the Written Law, but in many cases amplified and clarified by the Oral Law.

After that list of commands we find, “HaShem said to Moshe, ‘Write down these words, for it is on the basis of these words that I have made a Covenant with you and with Israel.’” (Shemos 34:27)

The Baal HaTurim cites Gittin 60b on this verse, where it says that “ ‘these words’ refer to “Torah she-B’al Peh,” the Oral Law. He also cites Midrash Tanchuma (Tisa 28) on ‘for it is on the basis of these words:’ and near that the Torah writes ‘and he was there with HaShem for forty days...’ to imply that he was there so long in order to study the Oral Law.”

Megilas Esther also contains verses which are interpreted to mean that it was at that time that the Jewish People fully accepted the “Torah she-B’Al Peh,” whereas until this point, they had only fully accepted the Written Law. They are “And the Jews took upon themselves to complete that which they had begun.” (Esther 9:23) and, even more compelling, “The Jews fulfilled and fully accepted upon themselves and upon their children and upon those who came to be associated with them, in such manner as not to fail, to incorporate these two days of celebration according to the instructions associated with them and according to the appointed time thereof, for all future years. And that these days should be remembered and kept throughout every generation, every family, every province and every city; and that these days should not fail from among the Jews, nor the remembrance of them perish from their seed.” (Esther 9:27-28)
