Parashios Netzavim Vayelech Valedictorian with a Fault

The entire Sefer Devarim is the valedictory address of "Moshe Rabbeinu" to the Children of Israel. If anyone deserved to be valedictorian, it was Moshe. After all, HaShem said about him, "...In all of My House, he is the most trustworthy. Mouth to mouth do I speak to him, in a clear vision and not in riddles, at the image of HaShem does he gaze..." (BaMidbar 12:7-8)

Moshe said to the people, "Velo itchem levadchem..." - "Not with you alone" - do I make this covenant and this oath; but with him that stands here with us, before the L-rd our G-d, and also with him who is not here with us this day." (Devarim 29: 13-14) As the "Adon HaNevi'im," the Master of the Prophets, he had the prophetic power to see all of the Jewish People, to the end of time standing together at the foot of the mountain to become obligated in the Covenant. He received the Torah on Mt. Sinai, where "He ate no bread and drank no water" (Shemos 34:28) during his 40-day stay on top of the mountain, learning Torah from its Author.

Yet, when Moshe asked HaShem to fulfill his greatest desire, to enter "Eretz Yisrael," his request was denied because Moshe had failed a crucial test of leadership. According to one opinion, when the People of Israel had rowdily expressed their desire for water, Moshe had lost his temper, and relating to the People of Israel with anger instead of compassion, he had lost an opportunity to sanctify G-d's Name, had called the people "rebels" when he said "Listen now, you rebels" (BaMidbar 20:10), and had hit the rock which HaShem had commanded him to speak gently to. This one-time departure from his usual calm demeanor had been sufficient to cause HaShem to reject his request. Moshe prayed 515 times to cause HaShem to "change His Mind," as it were, until HaShem said to him, "You have already had much" (Devarim 3:26) and ordered him to stop praying, because it would have been impossible for HaShem to reject Moshe's prayers.

Koheles, the wisest of men, advises strongly against the use of anger - "And remove anger from your heart" (Koheles 11:10), because "anger rests in the bosom of fools" (Koheles 7:3).

Alas, life is short; there is no time to waste on anger. How many spouses will one have in his lifetime? How many parents? And the Torah commands, "Honor your father and your mother" (Shemos 20:12)! How many children, siblings, friends and fellow travelers in G-d's world? And about them all the Torah commands "Love your neighbor as yourself" (VaYikra 19:18)!

Don't let only the "big things" bother you and arouse your anger, because at the end of the day, even the "big things" will seem little.

The Second Temple was destroyed because of "sinas chinam," hatred without a cause. The Torah's perspective vastly prefers "ahavas chinam," love without a cause, even for those who seem to be enemies, because perhaps your gesture will cause them to become your friends.

Jewish tradition, indeed Jewish Law cautions against feeling anger on the High Holy Days, when the Judge of All-the-World examines our accounts. And at least till Yom Kippur, and maybe by then it will have become a habit, one should stifle one's anger, and encourage love towards our fellow Jews and our fellow human beings.
