Parashas Bo "Layl Shimurim hu La-HaShem" "It was a Night of Protection from HaShem" (Shemos 12:42)

(The following is a partial translation of a Dvar Torah on Parashas Bo taken from Rav Shimon Schwab, ZT"L's "Ma'ayan Bais HaSho'eva")

"One of the themes of Parashas Bo is that the first night of Pesach is called 'Layl Shimurim,' 'A Night of Protection.' To understand this, it is necessary to focus on the meaning of the question of the 'wise son,' and of his father's response. The meaning of the question is not 'What are the 'mitzvos' of the night of Pesach?' Here the word 'mah' does not mean 'what;' the wise son is rather expressing an element of surprise and wonderment at an aspect of the Laws of Pesach, as in *Tehilim (104:24)*, 'Mah rabu ma'asecha, HaShem!' – 'How great are Your actions, HaShem!' For indeed the events of the Exodus closely match the miraculous events for which an individual is obliged to bring a Thanksgiving Offering to HaShem (cf. Berachos 54b): he was saved from a condition of imprisonment or slavery, he crossed a sea, he traveled through a Wilderness, he was cured of a serious illness. If so, just as some of the 'lachmei todah' were 'chometz' and others were 'matzah,' so too should the 'Lechem Oni' of Pesach be some 'chometz' and some of 'matzah!' **Why on the night of Pesach is there a requirement of exclusivity for matzah?** And similarly for the other questions."

"Thus, we must say that the answer the father gives his son, the reason for the exclusivity is that the essence of the Exodus from Egypt is the **Revelation of HaShem; 'I and not an angel; I and not a fiery being; I and not a messenger'** – and each year, when the time comes, there is a revelation of the Light of HaShem, as it says, 'It is a night of protection from HaShem, to take them out of Egypt' (Shemos 12:42) and, doubling the expression, 'It is a night of protection from HaShem for all the Children of Israel, for all their generations,' to indicate that **revelation is held in store for the Children of Israel in all of their generations.** And it says, 'It is this night of HaShem' – as if, and as it were, the Holy One, Blessed is He, Who is presiding at each festive meal, He Himself, in His Glory, at the Seder of each individual."

"And for that reason, the Chumash says, 'We were slaves to Pharaoh in Egypt and HaShem our G-d took us out' for that is the true depth of the Exodus from Egypt, the Revelation of HaShem. **And it is us as well** that He takes out by means of His Revelation... and 'Even if we were all wise...' with respect to the complicated laws of Pesach, 'we would be obligated to speak of the inner aspect of the Exodus, to see and to show the Revelation of HaShem, and as the Holy One, Blessed be He is infinite, so everyone who delves deeper and deeper into the recounting of those events, is to be praised.'"

"And the Author of the Haggadah goes on to recount the story of Rabbi Eliezer and his colleagues, who were delving into the Exodus 'all that night' – which, on the face of it, is difficult, because the 'Korban Pesach' is eaten only until midnight. Nevertheless, even after these great scholars finished performing all the 'mitzvos' prescribed for that night, they continued delving deeper and deeper into the core of the Exodus, until they reached the level of 'accepting the yoke of Heaven in Truth,' and at that moment their students arrived and told them that it was time for 'Krias Shema shel Shacharis.'"
