Parashas Devarim "Shabbos Chazon"

This Shabbos is known as "Shabbos Chazon," because that is the first word of the Haftarah: "Chazon Yeshayahu ben Amotz," which is always read on the Shabbos preceding Tishah B'Av.

It is associated with Parashas Devarim, which concludes with the wars against Sichon and Og, which marked the beginning of the conquest of Eretz Yisrael, even though those lands were not within the boundaries of the Holy Land. They were the lands granted to Reuven, Gad and half of Shevet Menashe, and will only be joined to Eretz Yisrael at the time of the Mashiach.

The two and a half tribes showed how a deviation from the practice of the rest of the nation should be handled. At the end of Parashas Matos, the Torah describes the motivation of those tribes to the Emori lands as being based on the fact that they were splendid pasture land. At first, Moshe accused them of following in the footsteps of the Meraglim, in turning the people away from Eretz Yisrael. But they immediately showed that their faith in HaShem was far greater than that of the Meraglim. For they swore to lead the People of Israel into battle against the Canaanite occupants of the Holy Land, and not to return to their homes until the entire land was conquered. On the day that the war against Sichon began, HaShem said, "This day I shall begin to place dread and fear on the peoples under the entire heaven..." (Devarim 2:25) And, after the defeat of Sichon and Og, Moshe says, "I commanded Yehoshua at that time, saying, Your eyes have seen everything that HaShem, your God, has done to these two kings, so will HaShem do to all the kings when you cross over. You shall not fear them, for HaShem, your God – He shall wage war for you.' " (Devarim 3:21-22)

"Haftaras Chazon"

By the time of the Haftarah, many hundreds of years later, Israel had a Temple, built by Shlomo HaMelech, but they were now in grave danger of losing it. For they were guilty of the three Cardinal Sins: idol-worship, bloodshed, and sexual immorality. They had ignored the teachings of nine major prophets preceding Yeshayahu. The "Vision of Yeshayahu" is as follows:

"The Vision of Yeshayahu, son of Amoz which he saw concerning Yehudah and Yerushalayim, in the days of Uzziah, Yotham, Achaz and Chizkiyahu, kings of Yehudah: Hear O heavens; and give ear. O earth, for HaShem has spoken: 'Children have I raised and exalted, but they have rebelled against Me. The ox knows his owner, and a donkey his master's trough; Israel does not know; My people does not perceive." (Yeshayahu 1:1-3)

"Hear the Word of Hashem, O Chiefs of Sodom; give ear to the Torah of our God, O people of Amora! Why do I need your numerous sacrifices? - says HaShem - I am satiated with elevation offerings of rams and the choicest of fattened animals...When you come to appear before Me - Who sought this from your hand, to trample My courtyards?" (Yeshayahu 1:10-12)

"Wash yourselves, purify yourselves, remove the evil of your doings from before My eyes; desist from doing evil. Learn to do good, seek justice, strengthen the victim, do justice for the orphan, take up the cause of the widow." (Yeshayahu 1:16-17)

"Go forth, now, let us reason together – says HaShem – if your sins would be like scarlet, they will whiten like snow; if they have reddened like crimson, they will become as wool. If you will be willing, and you will obey, you will eat the goodness of the land. But if you refuse and rebel, you shall be devoured by the sword – for the mouth of HaShem has spoken." (Yeshayahu 1:18-20)

"And now, echoing one of the petitions of the 'Shemoneh Esray,' 'Return our judges as at earlier times, and our counselors as at first...' ('Shemoneh Esray' 'Return our Judges' prayer) - '... after that, you shall be called 'City of Righteousness,' 'Faithful City.' Zion shall be redeemed with justice, and her returnees with righteousness." (1:26-27)




