Parashas Eikev Blessings of Rain

Parashas Eikev opens on the following cheerful note:

"This shall be the reward when you hearken to these ordinances, and observe and perform them; Ha-Shem, your God, will safeguard for you the covenant and the kindness that He swore to your forefathers. He will love you, bless you, and multiply you, and He will bless the fruit of your womb and the fruit of your Land; your grain, your wine, and your oil; the offspring of your cattle and the flocks of your sheep and your goats; on the Land that He swore to your forefathers to give you..." (Devarim 7:12-13)

Along the same lines are the following promises from the second paragraph of "Krias Shema:"

"It will be that if you hearken to My commandments that I command you today, to love HaShem your God and to serve Him with all your heart and all your soul, that I will provide rain for your Land in their proper times, the early rain and the late rain, that you may gather in your grain, your wine and your oil. I shall provide grass in your field for your cattle and you will eat and be satisfied." (Devarim 11:13-15)

But then comes a warning:

"Beware for yourselves, lest your heart be seduced and you turn astray and serve gods of others and prostrate yourselves to them. Then the wrath of HaShem will blaze against you. He will restrain the heavens so there will be no rain, and the ground will not yield its produce; and you will be swiftly banished from the goodly Land that HaShem gives you." (Devarim 11:16-17)

Then the "Tefilin shel Yad" upon your arm, opposite the heart, and the "Tefilin shel Rosh" upon one's forehead, opposite the brain, containing the soul, are appointed as guardians. *"You shall place these words of Mine upon your heart and upon your soul; you shall bind them for a sign upon your arm and let them be set between your eyes. You shall teach them to your children to discuss them, while you sit in your home, and when you walk on the way, when you retire and when you arise. And you shall write them on the doorposts of your home, and upon your gate. In order to prolong your days and the days of your children upon the Land that HaShem has sworn to your forefathers, to give them, like the days of the heavens over the earth." (Devarim 11:18-21)*

The importance of rain and water for life is highlighted in the Prayer for Rain recited on "Shemini Atzeres," some of the stanzas of which are listed below:

"May He obligate the Angel (Af-Beri) to give us portions of the separated rain,

To soften the wasteland's face when it is as dry as rock.

With water You symbolized Your might in Scripture,

To soothe with its drops those in whom was blown a soul;

To keep alive the ones who recall the strengths of the rain."

"Our God and the God of our Fathers"

"Remember the Patriarch Avraham who was drawn behind You like water;

You blessed him like a tree planted alongside streams of water,

You shielded him, You rescued him from fire and from water.

You tested him when he sowed upon all waters.

Cong. – For his sake, do not hold water back!"

"Chazzan:

For You are HaShem, our God, Who makes the winds blow and the rains descend:

For blessing and not for curse! (Cong. – Amen!)

For life and not for death! (Cong. – Amen!)

For plenty and not for scarcity! (Cong. – Amen!)"
