## Parashas Nitzavim - Reflections of the Selichos in Neilah

This year, 5775, during the week before we read Parashas Nitzavim, we recite "Selichos," Penitential Prayers, each morning, beginning with Motzaei Shabbos Parashas Ki-Savo, according to the tradition of "As the Day of Rest departs, we come before You first of all..." At the end of Yom Kippur, the Prayer of "Neilah," "Locking the Heavenly Doors," is recited. It is interesting to note that there is a correspondence between some of the "Pizmonim," Choruses, of the "Selichos" and parts of "Neilah," which is the subject of this essay.

"Selichah 7" – Chorus

"Israel is saved by HaShem with an eternal Salvation;

Today, too, may they be saved by Your Word,

O Dweller in the Heights –

For You are abundantly forgiving, and the Master of Mercies."

The above is the first stanza of a "Pizmon," a Chorus, recited on the Second Day of "Selichos," stanzas of which are repeated in the "Neilah" Prayer of Yom Kippur.

A second example is the following: "Selichah 16" (Chorus)

"Let us hear from Him Who sits in celestial concealment, 'I have forgiven!'

By His right-hand's salvation, may the poor and destitute people be saved.

When we cry out to you, in Your righteousness, respond with awesome deeds –

'O HaShem, be our helper!'

The above is the first stanza of a chorus recited on the Fifth Day of "Selichos," and repeated in "Neilah."

Erev Rosh HaShanah is the longest group of "Selichos"; consequently, the largest group of "Selichos" which we are considering comes from that set. A third example: "Selichah 42" (Chorus)

"Remember the Covenant that You made with Avraham and Akeidas Yitzchok:

And Return the captivity of the tents of Yaakov, and save us for the sake of Your Name."

A fourth example, also a Chorus from "Selichah 42" of Erev Rosh HaShanah is the following:

"The Holy City and its suburbs have become a disgrace and been looted,

All her treasures have been buried and hidden –

And there is nothing left but the Torah.

Restore the captivity of Yaakov's tents,

And save us for Your Name's Sake."

The fifth and final example of duplication between the "Selichos" and "Neilah," also from "Selichah 42" is as follows:

"Mighty Redeemer, Redeem us for Your Sake, and see that our hand is weak,

And observe that the merit of our righteous deeds is greatly diminished,

And there is no one to pray for us;

And return the captivity of Yaakov's tents for Your Name's Sake."

Our prayer for assistance during the Days of Repentance builds to a crescendo in the "Neilah" Prayer, as the gates of Heaven are closed for another year. The "Shofar" is blown as the "Shekhinah," the Divine Presence, withdraws to its Heavenly Abode.
