Parashas Vayera - "He Revives the Dead with His Word"

The most dramatic part of Parashas Vayera is "Akeidas Yitzchok." where Avraham agrees to sacrifice his beloved son, Yitzchok, and Yitzchok acquiesces, until an Angel of God calls a halt to the drama, with Avraham sword-in-hand at Yitzchok's throat, saying that Avraham has sufficiently demonstrated his faith in God. Thus, Yitzchok is restored to Avraham, while, unfortunately, the shock of what might have happened is too much for Sarah, and she dies.

The Haftarah, taken from Sefer Melachim II, describes the interaction of the Prophet Elisha with two other righteous women of Israel, in each case with the story ending on a happier note for the women.

The Haftarah begins with the story of the widow of the Prophet Ovadiah, who has saved 100 righteous prophets, from Yehoram, who has lent him supplies at usurious rates. Yehoram is the son of the evil couple. Achay and Izevel, who has killed all the rest of the true prophets of Israel. Ovadiah's widow tells Elisha that if she cannot make the payments, Yehoram will take her two sons as slaves. Elisha asks her if she has anything of value in her house. She tells him that all she has is one cruse of oil and an empty jug. He tells her to collect more empty jugs from her friends and fill them with oil until they all run out. She does that and amasses a large amount of oil. Elisha suggests she pay off the creditor, and use the rest for her household needs.

Another is a story, involving a woman from Shunam who generously provides Elisha with accommodations in her home. Elisha asks the woman if he could ask a favor for her from the government. She declines politely, saying "I am living among my people." (Melachim II (4:13)) After a while, Elisha asks Geichazi, his servant, what he could possibly do to make the woman happier. Geichazi informs Elisha that the woman is childless. Elisha tells the woman that "next year at this time, she will be embracing a son; but she responds, 'Master, please do not deceive your handmaiden.' " (Melachim II (4:16))

The woman conceived and gave birth to a son. The boy grew up until one day he went out to his father's field and was seized by a tremendous head pain. He was carried to his mother and died in her lap. She saddled a donkey and left for the home of Elisha on Mt. Carmel. "She said to the prophet. 'Did I request a son from my master? Did I not say, 'Do not deceive me!' Elisha sent Geichazi with his staff and strict instructions not to let anybody interrupt his journey. He lay the staff on the boy's face, but there was no sound and nothing was heard. He returned toward Elisha and told him, saying, 'The lad has not awakened.' " (Melachim II (4:31))

"Elisha himself entered the house and found the boy. Then he prayed to HaShem to restore life to him. Then he went up and lay upon the boy. He assumed the position of mouth-to-mouth, eye-to-eye, hand-to-hand. Elisha withdrew and walked about the house, once this way, and once that way, then he went up and prostrated himself upon him; the lad sneezed seven times and then opened his eyes." (Melachim II (4:32-35))

"He called to Geichazi and said, 'Summon the Shunammite woman.' He summoned her and she came to Elisha, who said, 'Pick up your son.' She came and fell at his feet in gratitude and bowed down to the ground; then she picked up her son and left." [Melachim II (4:36-37))
