Parashas Vayeshev Sir Martin Gilbert – Remnants of Esav's Cruelty

In last week's "Scholar-in-Residence" programs, there stood before us a "Rabbi with a Mission." He described "The Holy Jewish Treasures in the Vatican: A Miracle on a Mission to Rome." He said that high officials in the Vatican confessed that their library contained 6 million documents (whether he really meant that number or whether he knew that that number had terrifying implications for the Jewish People was a mystery he left to be solved). But he did allow another mystery to be solved; that of a text in Rambam which says that the three ways in which a man can be "mekadesh" a woman are all Biblical(!), contrary to the opinion of generations of "Talmidei Chachamin" in Israel and in the "Galus."

I'm going to refer again to the book, "The Righteous," by Sir Martin Gilbert, on the subject of righteous gentiles, specifically the chapter dealing with the behavior of our Italian brothers during World War II, and specifically how they behaved under pressure from their "allies," the Nazis. That chapter is "Italy and the Vatican."

"On the battlefields of Europe and North Africa, Italy was Germany's military ally. Italian soldiers fought alongside the Germans on the Eastern Front and were part of the occupation forces in Poland. There, to the fury of the Germans, Jews in both Lvov and Brody had acquired arms from Italian troops stationed in the town. To the distress of German occupation forces stationed in the east, the Italians seemed to lack entirely any hatred of the Jews; for their part, Italians called anti-Semitism 'the German disease.'"

"The Vatican also distressed the Nazi hierarchy. After Pope Pius XII's Christmas Mass in 1942, the German bureau in Berlin responsible for the deportation of the Jews noted angrily, 'In a manner never known before, the Pope has repudiated the National Socialist New European Order... Here he is virtually accusing the German People of injustice towards the Jews and makes himself the mouthpiece of the Jewish war criminals.'"

"News of the Italian obduracy reached the Head of the SS, Heinrich Himmler, who wrote to the German Foreign Minister, Joachim von Ribbentrop, on 29 January 1943 to stress 'the grave security problems' which Italian resistance to the Final Solution was creating throughout the territories under Axis control.' Four days later, Vatican Radio was reported to have broadcast a papal injunction: 'He who makes a distinction between Jews and other men is unfaithful to God and is in conflict with God's commands.'"

"In October 1943, having established their presence in Rome, the SS were determined to deport the city's 5,000 Jews to the death camps. In an attempt to forestall the deportation, the Vatican clergy opened the sanctuaries of Vatican City to all 'non-Aryans' in need of refuge. Catholic clergymen throughout Rome acted with alacrity. At the Capuchin convent... Father Benoit... saved large numbers of Jews by providing them with false identification papers. He was helped in doing this by members of various Embassies in Rome and also by Mario di Marco, a senior police official, who was later tortured by the Gestapo but did not disclose what he knew."

"In the remote village of Canale d'Alba, in Piedmont, Matteo Raimondo, a 'sturdy farmer,' his wife Marietta, his son Beppe and his daughter Juccia protected five Italian Jews from Genoa: Giuseppe Levi, his wife Bettina, and their three children, Ida, Elia and Pia... We felt that the Raimondo family was still protecting us, throughout the whole period: Juccia used to come over to us now and again, riding on her bicycle, to bring us money and news... Many years later, as Elia Levi recalled, 'we learnt of yet another honest deed of this generous family of friends: before going into the hiding, our mother had entrusted to Marietta a box containing cash, money and family jewels, asking her to keep it for us. But, as she understood the dangers ahead, we told her that should we not come back, that is should we be deported, she should keep all of it. It goes without saying that the box, which had been buried somewhere in the property, was returned to our Mother after the war as the most natural thing.'"
