Parashas Vayakhel— The Building of the Mishkan

The Sprinkling of Water in the Temple and the Menorah, the Symbol of Chanukah

When Moshe came down from Har Sinai the first time, and saw the Jewish People dancing around the "Egel HaZahav," the Golden Calf, and performing other serious sins, he could not understand what had gotten into them, and he broke the first set of "luchos," which HaShem had given him, an act for which HaShem congratulated him, "Fortunate are you, that you broke them!"

Moshe assuaged HaShem's fierce anger against His People, learned Torah from Him for forty days and forty nights, and returned with a new set of "luchos," and a promise to build a "Mishkan," a home for HaShem amidst a repentant Children of Israel.

Moshe informs the People of the appointment of Bezalel ben Uri ben Chur of the Tribe of Yehudah. He will work together with Oholiav ben Achisomoch of the Tribe of Dan. Bezalel and Achisomoch begin the immense work, together with "every wise-hearted man within whom HaShem had endowed wisdom and insight to know and to do all the work for the labor of the Mishkan." (Shemos 36:1) And the people continued their donations "morning after morning." (Shemos 36:3) "All the wise people came – and they said to Moshe, as follows: 'The people are bringing more than enough for the work that HaShem has commanded to perform.'" (Shemos 36:5)

"The wise hearted among those doing the work for the 'Mishkan' made: ten curtains of linen, twisted with turquoise, purple and scarlet wool; they made them with a woven design of 'Keruvim.'" (Shemos 36:8) "...with a certain length and a certain width. (Bezalel) attached five curtains one to another, he made fifty loops on the end of one curtain, and fifty on the other... he made fifty clasps of gold – so the 'Mishkan' became one!" (Shemos 36:13) "Bezalel made the ark of acacia wood, covering it with pure gold, inward and outward. He made a cover of pure gold, with two 'Keruvim,' with wings spread outward, toward the cover were their faces (Shemos 37:1-9)...He made the Menorah of pure gold, three branches on each side..." (Shemos 37:17-24)

Chanukah The symbol of Chanukah, which is approaching in three weeks, is the Menorah. Chanukah is a Rabbinically-Ordained eight-day Festival. The historical events which it celebrates are the defeat by the Macabim of the Hellenistic Jews, and the purification, again by the Macabim, of the Temple after its defilement by the Greeks. A miracle which occurred at the time was the burning of the Menorah for eight days even though there was enough oil only for one day.

Succos – Simchas Beis HaSho'evah – "How is the Water Libation done? He filled a golden flagon holding three lugim, from the Shiloach. When they reached the Water Gate, they sounded a Tekiah, a Teruah and a Tekiah. Chaza"l say, "Whoever did not see the 'Simchas Beis HaSho'evah,' never saw rejoicing in his lifetime." (Maseches Sukkah 5:1). At the conclusion of the first festival day of Succos they descended to the Women's Court... There were golden candleabra there with four golden bowls atop them, four ladders for each, and four youths from among the young priests holding pitchers of oil containing one hundred and twenty log, which they had poured into each bowl." (Maseches Succah 5:2)... "There was not a courtyard in Yerushalayim that was not illuminated by the light of the Bais HaSho'evah." (Maseches Succah 5:3) ... "Devout men and men of good deeds would dance before them with the flaming torches that were in their hands and would utter before them words of song and praises, and the Levites would play with harps, lyres, cymbals, trumpets, and countless musical instruments while standing on the fifteen steps that descend from the Court of the Israelites to the Women's Court – corresponding to the fifteen Songs of Ascent, in Tehilim. Two Kohanim stood at the Upper Gate that descends from the Court of the Israelites to the Women's Court, with two trumpets in their hands. When the crier (Gevini, the Temple crier) – Shekalim (5:1) called out, they sounded a Tekiah, a Teruah and a Tekiah." (Maseches Succah 5:4)
