Parashas Pinchas—Jewish Leadership, Then and Now

In Revi'l of today's parashah, we find the following verses: "HaShem said to Moshe, 'Go up to this mountain of Avarim and see the Land that I have given to the Children of Israel. You shall see it and you shall be gathered unto your people, you, too, as Aharon, your brother, was gathered in; because you rebelled against My word in the Wilderness of Zin, in the assembly's strife, to sanctify Me at the water before their eyes." (BaMidbar 27: 12-14)

After Moshe has learned that he will not lead the Jewish People into the Holy Land, we find the following, "Moshe spoke to HaShem, saying, 'May HaShem, God of the spirits of all flesh, appoint a man over the assembly, who shall go out before them, and come in before them...and let the assembly of HaShem not be like sheep that have no shepherd.' " (BaMidbar 27:15-17)

"HaShem said to Moshe, 'Take for yourself Yehoshua bin Nun, a man in whom there is spirit, and lean your hand upon him. You shall stand him before Elazar the Kohen and before the entire assembly, and command him before their eyes. You shall place some of your majesty upon him, so that the entire assembly of the Children of Israel will pay heed. Before Elazar the Priest shall he stand, who shall inquire for him of the 'Urim' before HaShem; at his word shall they go out and at his word they shall come in, he and all the Children of Israel with him, and the entire assembly." (BaMidbar 27: 18-21)

There are elections coming in the United States, and I cannot make up my mind whom to vote for. There are many positive things that people say about Hillary Rodham Clinton, the Democratic candidate for President, besides the fact that she has made history by being the first female candidate for President of the United States, including the fact that she's generally fair, highly intelligent, compassionate, devoted to women's issues, the poor, and color-blind. Unfortunately, there are also some negative things that people have said: that she's sometimes crooked, deceptive and mean. On the other side of the ballot, is the Republican candidate, Donald J.
