## Parashas Haazinu— Moshe and Yeshayahu

At the beginning of Parashas Haazinu, Moshe Rabbeinu calls for the second time (the first was in Parashat Nitzavim; Devarim 30:19), heaven and earth to witness his warning to the People of Israel that they must obey HaShem's Commandments:

**"Give ear, O heavens, and I will speak;**

And **let the earth hear** the words of my mouth." (Devarim 32:1)

Yet we find still another time that the same witnesses are summoned to court, at the beginning of the Haftarah of Shabbos Chazon, by the Prophet Yeshayahu:

**"Hear, O heavens, and give ear, O earth;**

For HaShem Has Spoken." (Yeshayahu 1:2)

The question arises, why was the nature of the summons switched by Yeshayahu, who changed **"Give ear"** from the heavens to the earth, and **"hear"** from the earth to the heavens?

The Sifri on Haazinu 306 asks the question and gives the following answer, "that Yeshayahu, who said 'Hear, O heavens,' was far from the heavens, and 'give ear, O earth,' because he was close to the earth."

Of course, saying Yeshayahu was far from the heavens is only reasonable when he is compared to Moshe, about whom HaShem said, "he is trusted in all My Palace!" (Bamidbar 12:7). For Yeshayahu was also a spiritual giant. Chaza"l say about him that he was more reticent about his vision of the Heavenly Throne Room (Yeshayahu, Chapter 6) than Yechezkel about his (Yechezkel Chapters 1,2,3:1-15), because Yeshayahu was more "at home," so to speak, in the heavenly precincts, than Yechezkel. On the other hand, Moshe was the greatest human being who has ever lived, since the time of "Adam HaRishon," First Man in Gan Eden, before the "sin," who may have been greater, but then he played in a different league!

When Moshe gave them "Mussar," Reproof, the People of Israel could say, "Moshe is so far above us that what applies to him doesn't apply to us." Came Yeshayahu, more obviously an earthly mortal just like them, and gave them the same warning - now they could no longer push it away.

Yeshayahu spoke to us on "Shabbos Chazon," right before Tisha B'Av, the Day of Destruction of both of our Holy Temples. Moshe speaks to us this year on Shabbos Shuvah, the Shabbat before Yom Kippur, the holiest day of the year, when the People of Israel is raised to the highest level and become "like the angels."

The Talmud, in Maseches Taanis, interprets the verses in Yeshayahu (21:11-12) as follows:

" 'Watchman, what of the night?' The People of Israel said, 'Our Master, Yeshayahu, what will come to us out of this night?' "

"He said to them, 'Wait for me until I ask.' "

"Once he had asked, he returned to them and they asked again, 'Watchman, what of the night? - What did HaShem, the Watchman of the Worlds, say?' "

"He answered them, 'The Watchman said, **"Both morning and night are coming;** morning for the righteous and night for the wicked.' "

"They asked, 'When?' "

"He answered, 'Whenever **you want it** to happen.' "

"They asked further, 'What does it depend on?' "

"He answered, 'It depends on **"Teshuvah,"** Repentance.' "
