Parashas Lech Lecha - Avraham, the "Amud HaChesed" and "The Righteous"

In Israel, there stands a place set aside as a monument to the Holocaust, and to Righteous Gentiles, called "Yad VaShem," "Honor and Renown," based on the following verse: "In My house and within My walls, I will give them a place of honor and renown, which is better than sons and daughters; eternal renown will I give them, which will never be terminated." (Yeshayahu 56:5)

One of Britain's most respected historians, Sir Martin Gilbert, wrote a book dedicated to Righteous Gentiles, in which he assembled many testimonials to that group of heroes:

"A quite unexpected problem arose when, in Jerzy Krupinsky's words, 'One day Ryszard arrived very embarrassed, telling us that he was getting married. His fiancé, Edyta Nestorowicz, was of German extraction, but her father had been sent to Auschwitz – for not signing the register of ethnic Germans... After a few days, Ryszard came home beaming with joy. He spoke to Edyta and she asked him, crying: 'How can we ask them to leave? How do we know whether they have a place to go?' So we stayed with them for almost two years, treated not as Jews or even tenants, but as members of the family.' "

"Jerzy Kupinsky also noted: 'Pauline once asked Ryszard's mother why she exposed herself, her son and daughter-in-law to such a mortal danger. She answered: 'Men can do so little one for another, and it is, therefore, his duty to do so for those who need help...'"

"The historian of this episode, Yaffa Eliach, has written of how Mrs. Jachowitz became very attached to the little boy, loved his bright inquiring eyes, took great pride in her 'son' and took him regularly to church. Soon, he knew by heart all the Sunday hymns.. "

"A devout Catholic, Mrs. Jachowitz wanted to have Shachne baptized. With this in mind, she went to see a young parish priest, Karol Wojtyla, who had a reputation for wisdom and trustworthiness. Revealing the secret of the boy's identity, Mrs. Jachowitz told the priest of her wish that Shachne should become a 'true Christian' and devout Catholic like herself. Wojtyla listened intently to the woman's story. When Mrs. Jachowitz finished, he asked, 'And what was the parents' wish, when they entrusted their only child to you and to your husband?' Mrs. Jachowitz then told him that Helen Hiller's last request had been that her son should be told of his Jewish origins, and 'returned to his people' if the parents died. Hearing this, Wojtyla replied that he would not perform the baptism ceremony. It would be unfair, he explained, to baptize the child while there was still hope that, once the war was over, his relatives might take him."

"Shachne Hiller survived the war and was eventually united with his relatives in the United States. Karol Wojtyla, the young priest who had ensured that the boy remained Jewish, was later to become Pope John Paul II."

"The French Lawyer and historian Serge Klarsfeld, a hidden child during the war, whose father was deported to Auschwitz and perished there, has stressed that the war against the Jews in France was more than anything a war against children. Between 1942 and 1944, 11,402 French children aged seventeen and under (some tiny babies) were deported, many of them without their parents. Only three hundred of those children survived. These harsh facts make the acts of rescue that did take place all the more remarkable, while also raising the ever-present question: What if more people had been able to take the risk of hiding Jews?"

"Above all, the stories of the Righteous emphasize, in the words of Mordecai Paldiel, 'the belief that man, if he is to be appreciated as a unique creature, is indeed endowed with a great capacity for goodness; for moral and ethical behavior. This bright and shining side of man, if put to full use, is more than enough to offset the other, and darker, side of man's behavior.' "
