Parashas Beshalach "From Here, is a Hint to the Resurrection of the Dead"

On this Shabbos, "Shabbos Shirah," we read Parashas Beshalach, which contains the "Shiras HaYam." They had experienced the great miracle of "Krias Yam Suf," "...and they had faith in HaShem, and in Moshe, His servant." (Shemos 14:31) In Midrash Mechilta, we find that even a simple maidservant at the sea perceived a higher degree of revelation than the Prophet Yechezkel in his Heavenly vision. Maseches Sotah 30b describes how the entire nation was elevated to the state of prophecy, even the babes and the sucklings: "The babe lay upon his mother's knees and the suckling sucked at his mother's breast. When they beheld the Shechinah, the babe raised his neck and the suckling released the nipple from his mouth, and they exclaimed, *"This is my G-d and I shall praise Him"* (Shemos 15:3), as it is said, *"Out of the mouths of babes and sucklings have You established Your strength."* (Tehilim 8:3)

There is much discussion among the commentators as to the meaning of the first words of the "Shirah," *"Oz yashir Moshe..."* (Shemos 15:1) Rashi comments on the plain meaning, "Then, when he saw the Miracle, he thought that he should sing the 'Shirah,' and did so," and he brings other examples of that usage, whereby the 'Yud' in 'Yashir' and in other similar words in the future tense, signifies thought. ArtScroll cites Rav Gedaliah Schorr as explaining that the mixture of tenses is found especially in prophecy, since the prophet speaks in the name of G-d. His alternating use of different tenses shows that G-d is not bound by time, as are mortals. Finally, Rashi says, "The above is to explain the plain meaning, but in Midrash, our Sages say that we have before us a hint to 'Techiyas HaMesim,' the Resurrection of the Dead, in the Torah," meaning that HaShem will bring the dead back to life in Messianic times, and then they will sing HaShem's praises once again.

Today is Wednesday, February 8, 2017, a mid-winter day of record-breaking warmth (62 degrees versus the old record of 61 degrees). Tomorrow will be Thursday, February 9, 2017, and all the meteorologists are in agreement that there will be a downward plunge in temperature, and a major snowstorm – (We find in Koheles the verse, *"Just as you do not know the way of the wind, nor the nature of the embryo in the pregnant womb, so can you never understand the work of G-d, Who makes everything."* (Koheles 11:5) Today, although there are many other mysteries in the world, the human being, with the aid of the "Chonen HaDa'as," the One Who endows the human being with intelligence, has created technologies such as radar and scanning machines which have rendered the phenomena mentioned by Koheles as no-longer mysteries) - and people know, with a high level of probability, that a storm is coming tomorrow. However, the science of meteorology is still limited; anything longer than a 7-day forecast is not much better than a guess.

However, Prophecy is far different, and is not limited, for it comes from a different realm than science; i.e. the realm of holiness. The prophet, Yirmiyahu, known as the Prophet of Destruction with respect to Yerushalayim and the "Bais HaMikdash," could see, through the prophetic lens, till the end-of-days. In the Haftarah for Parashas Bo, the final verse bothered me at first: *"You – do not be afraid, My servant, Yaakov – the word of HaShem – for I am with you; though I shall make an end of all the nations where I have dispersed you, but of you, I shall not make an end; I shall punish you with justice, but I shall not destroy you utterly."* (Yirmiyahu 46:28) I was puzzled by the expression *"I shall punish you with justice."* I immediately thought of the Holocaust – certainly a very harsh punishment – the righteous with the wicked, starvation, poison gas and cremation! Justice? In any case, the only One Who could bring back and heal the massive injuries was the "Healer of All Flesh, and the Doer of Wonders!" – Who would repair the broken hearts, and restore the destroyed bodies.

Yirmiyahu also pronounced beautiful prophecies regarding the ultimate redemption of Israel, *"I shall yet rebuild you and you shall be rebuilt, O Maiden of Israel...For there will be a day when watchmen will call out on Mount Ephraim, 'Arise, let us ascend to Zion, to HaShem, our G-d..."* (Yirmiyahu 31:3,5), and the following: *"Thus said HaShem, 'A voice is heard on high, wailing, bitter weeping; Rachel weeps for her children, for they are gone.' Thus said HaShem, 'Restrain your voice from weeping, and your eyes from tears; for there is reward for your accomplishment – the word of HaShem – and they will return from the enemy's land. There is hope for your future – the word of HaShem – and your children shall return to their border.' "* (Yirmiyahu 31:14-16)
