## Parashas Terumah – The Creation of the “Mishkan”

In the conclusion to his “Hakdamah,” Introduction, to the Book of Shemos, the Ramban writes as follows: “Now the exile was not completed until the day that they returned to their place and returned to the status of their fathers. When they left Egypt, even though they came forth from the ‘House of Bondage,’ they were still considered exiles because they were *‘in a land that was not theirs’* (Bereshis 15:13), wandering in the desert. When they came to Mount Sinai, and made the ‘Mishkan,’ and the Holy One, blessed be He, caused His Divine Presence to dwell again amongst them, they returned to the status of their fathers when the “ ‘sod eloka’ (counsel of G-d) was upon their tents” and they “were those who constituted the ‘Chariot of the Holy One.’” (Bereshis Rabbah 47:8) Then they were considered redeemed. For this reason the second Book of the Torah is concluded with the consecration of the ‘Mishkan,’ and the glory of the Eternal filling it always.”

Parashas Terumah is the beginning of the realization of the dream of the Holy Nation dwelling with HaShem, the Author and “invisible embodiment” of Holiness, among them. The Parashah begins, “*HaShem spoke to Moshe, saying: ‘Speak to the Children of Israel and let them take for Me a donation, from everyone whose heart motivates him you shall take My portion.’*” (Shemos 25:1-2) This was not a Command. It was a purely voluntary request from the “King” for the donation of precious objects, which the Torah lists. So eager were the people to have a share in the construction of a resting place for the “Shechinah” that a halt had to be called to the collection process because of the overwhelming generosity of the people.

The “Mishkan” was - like the holy Temples that would be built hundreds of years later by Shelomo HaMelech and centuries later by the governor, Zerubavel and the counsel of the prophets Chaggai and Zechariah, under the authority of the Persian King Daryavesh, son of Queen Esther, and millennia later, the Third Temple which will be built, soon and in our time, by the Mashiach - the spiritual center of the people. Although physical beauty was also essential; “*They shall make an Ark of acacia wood, two and a half cubits its length, a cubit and a half its width, and a cubit and a half its height. You shall cover it with pure gold, from within and from without shall you cover it, and you shall make a gold crown all around*” (Shemos 25:10-11), for there shall be no hint of poverty in the palace of the King of Kings.

“*And you shall place in the Ark the Tablets of Witness that I shall give you. You shall make a Cover of pure gold...*” (the “shoresh,” or root, of the Hebrew word for the Cover, the “Kaporet,” contains the Hebrew letters “Koff,” “Pai,” and “Resh,” perhaps suggesting “Kapparah,” Atonement for the Sin of the Golden Calf), “...*You shall make two ‘Keruvim’ of gold...*” – (Each had the innocent face of an infant) – “*The ‘Keruvim’ shall be with wings spread upward, sheltering the ‘Kaporet’ with their wings, with their faces towards one another; towards the ‘Kaporet’ shall be the faces of the ‘Keruvim’...*” suggesting, perhaps, the combination of ‘bein Adam le-chaveiro,’ between one human being and another, and ‘bein Adam la-Makom,’ between the human being and the Eternal. “*It is there that I will set My meetings with you, and I shall speak with you from atop the ‘Kaporet,’ from between the two ‘Keruvim,’ that are on the Ark of the Tablets of Witness, everything that I shall command to the Children of Israel.*” (Shemos 25:16-18, 20, 22)
