Parashas Devarim-"Shabbos Chazon"

This Shabbos is called "Shabbos Chazon," because the Haftarah of Parashas Devarim, the third of the Haftaros of "Puronisa," (Divine) Punishment, begins "Chazon Yeshayahu ben Amotz..." "The vision of Yeshayahu son of Amotz..." (Yeshayahu 1:1) in which the details of the severe punishment HaShem is preparing to administer to His Holy City and His Chosen People, because of their immoral behavior, are spelled out, unless they repent. "How has she become a harlot! – a faithful city that was full of justice, in which righteousness was wont to lodge, but its citizens are now murderers...for the orphan they do no justice, the cause of the widow does not come unto them." (Yeshayahu 1:21,23) But after the "Makkah," the punishing blow, will come the "Refuah," the healing, "Then I will return your judges as in earliest times, and your counselors as at first, after that you shall be called City of Righteousness, Faithful City. Zion (Yerushalayim) shall be redeemed with justice, and her returnees with righteousness." (Yeshayahu 1:26-27)

We see that the prophetic term for seeing, "Chazon," "Vision," has two sides, negative and positive; frightful punishment, the destruction of our Temple, the "Bais HaMikdash," our spiritual center, and literally, the annihilation of millions of Jews, throughout the centuries. But there is an infinitely Righteous Divine Judge, Who forgets nobody and nothing, Who has promised, "I will bring back from Bashan, I will bring back from the depths of the sea." (Tehilim 68:23); from the gas chambers, the mass graves and the crematoria.

Iyov is probably the saddest figure in Tanach, considered the ultimately righteous person. until the Satan objected that he only appeared to be righteous, for he was leading a very pleasant life. He had riches, a wife, and many beautiful children. With nothing to complain about, why shouldn't he be faithful? But take away those blessings, and we'll see if he is really righteous! HaShem gave permission to the Satan to basically take away everything from Iyov, except his life! Iyov is reduced to a pitiful shell of his former self, so he clearly visualized and experienced the punishment side of "chazon;" yet he clung tenaciously to his faith, and said – אלוה מבשרי אחזה l have a vision of G-d from my flesh" (Iyov 19:26)

Rabbi Akiva was also famous for being able to see light even in total darkness. The Talmud in Makkos 24b tells the following story about Rabbi Akiva and his colleagues Rabban Gamliel, Rabbi Elazar ben Azariah and Rabbi Yehoshua: "Once they were going up to Yerushalayim, after its destruction by the Romans. When they reached Har HaTzofim, they tore their garments. When they reached the Temple Mount, they saw a fox coming out of the Place of the Holy of Holies. His colleagues began to cry, but Rabbi Akiva was laughing. They asked him, 'Why are you laughing?' He responded, 'Why are you crying?' They said to him, 'The Place about which the Torah says, 'And the stranger who approaches it will die' (BaMidbar 1:51) - and now we see foxes walking freely in that Place, should we not cry?' He said to them, 'That is exactly why I am laughing. For it is written 'And I have appointed reliable witnesses: Uriah HaCohen and Zecharyahu ben Berechyahu.' (Yeshayahu 8:2) Now what do Uriah and Zecharvah have to do with each other? Uriah lived at the time of the First Temple and Zecharyah lived at the time of the Second Temple! But Scripture made the prophecy of Zechariah dependent on the prophecy of Uriah. In the prophecy of Uriah it is written, 'Therefore, because of you, Zion will be ploughed like a field...' (Michah 3:12) In the prophecy of Zechariah it is written, 'Old men and old women will yet sit in the streets of Yerushalayim.' (Zechariah 8:4) As long as the prophecy of Uriah had not been fulfilled, I had feared that the prophecy of Zecharyah would not be fulfilled. Now that the prophecy of Uriah has been fulfilled, and Yerushalayim and the Temple Mount are totally desolate, I know that the prophecy of Zechariah will be fulfilled. His colleagues said to him: "Akiva, you have comforted us; Akiva, you have comforted us."
