Parashas Ki Savo *The Sixth Haftarah of Comfort*

Looking back at the 20th century, one last paroxysm of terror and horror was visited upon the Jewish People; namely, the Holocaust, from 1939 through 1945, and the defeat of Amalek-Germany. ונאמן Since then, the State of Israel was declared, it has won several miraculous or near-miraculous victories over its Arab enemies, its level of Torah learning has risen dramatically, and its population and technical prowess have multiplied many-fold.

In the weeks before Rosh HaShanah, Jewish Tradition has identified Ten Haftaros, Three of Punishment, and Seven of Comfort, that accompanied our People through its thousands of years of Exile through the present, when we appear to have entered, hopefully, the time of , the Beginning of Redemption.

The first two prophecies were pronounced by Yirmiyahu, the Prophet-Witness, who said in Megilas Eichah, "I am the man who has seen affliction by the rod of His anger." (Eichah 3:1). The Prophet Yeshayahu pronounced the final Prophecy of Punishment, "חזון ישעיהו" (Yeshayahu 1:1)

The first Haftarah of Punishment contains the verses, "For behold! I will call all the families of the kingdoms of the north - the Word of HaShem - and they shall come and each of them shall place his throne at the entranceway of the gates of Yerushalayim... Then I shall speak My judgment against them for all their evil; for they have forsaken Me." (Yirmiyahu 1:15-16)

But even in this Prophecy of Punishment, the Prophets of Israel could not leave the matter all doom and gloom. For we find, "And the Word of HaShem was upon me, saying, 'Go and proclaim in the ears of Yerushalayim saying, 'Thus said HaShem: 'I remember for your sake the kindness of your youth, the love of your bridal days, your following after Me in the wilderness, in a land not sown...'" (Yirmiyahu 2:1-2) And the "Vision of Yeshayahu" concludes in its last two (of twenty-seven) verses, "Then I will return your judges as at the earliest time... after that you shall be called City of Righteousness, Faithful City. Tziyon will be redeemed with justice, and her returnees with righteousness." (Yeshayahu 1:26-27)

The first Haftarah of the final seven begins, appropriately enough, "Be comforted, be comforted, My people, says your G-d." (Yeshayahu 40:1)

The second Haftarah begins, "And Tziyon said, 'HaShem has forsaken me; my L-rd has forgotten me.'" (Yeshayahu 49:14) And HaShem responds, "Can a woman forget her nursing infant, withdraw from feeling compassion for the child of her womb? Even were they to forget, I would not forget you." (Yeshayahu 49:15)

The third Haftarah contains the verse, "All your children will be students of HaShem, and abundant will be your children's peace." (Yeshayahu 54:13)

The fourth Haftarah begins with the ultimate comfort: HaShem says, "It is I, I am He that comforts you..." (Yeshayahu 51:12)

The fifth Haftarah contains these verses: "For but a brief moment have I forsaken you, and with abundant mercy shall I gather you in. With a slight wrath have I concealed My countenance from you for a moment, but with eternal kindness shall I show you mercy, said your Redeemer, Ha-Shem." (Yeshayahu 54:7-8)

The sixth Haftarah, that of this Shabbos, begins, "Arise! Shine! For your light has arrived, and the Glory of HaShem has shined upon you... Lift your eyes about you and see... Your sons from afar shall come and your daughters shall be nurtured alongside." (Yeshayahu 60:1, 4)

The seventh Haftarah begins ecstatically, "I will rejoice intensely with HaShem, my soul shall exult with my G-d, for He has dressed me in the raiment of salvation, in a robe of righteousness has He cloaked me, like a bridegroom who dons priestly glory, like a bride who bedecks herself in her jewelry." (Yeshayahu 61:10)

Looking back, the sixth Haftarah concludes, "The smallest shall increase a thousand-fold and the least into a mighty nation; I am HaShem, in its time, I will hasten it." (Yeshayahu 60:22) Chazal interpret the expression "In its time, I will hasten it" as "If the Jewish People will do Teshuvah, I will hasten its Redemption. If not, Redemption will still come, but at a slower pace." Let us hope that our People will do Teshuvah, acting in accordance with the Law, inspiring respect and admiration; then, its Redemption will come quickly.
