Parashas Mishpatim – Justice, According to the Torah

Parashas Mishpatim begins as follows: (A short synopsis) *“And these are the ordinances that you shall place before them...”* (Shemos 21:1):

“One who strikes a man, so that he dies, shall surely be put to death” (Shemos 21:12)

“One who strikes his father or mother, shall surely be put to death” (Shemos 21:15)

“You shall not taunt or oppress a stranger, for you were strangers in the Land of Egypt. You shall not cause pain to any widow or orphan. If you dare to cause him pain! For if he shall cry out to Me, I shall surely hear his outcry...and I shall kill you by the sword, and your wives will be widows and your children, orphans.” (Shemos 22:20-23)

“Distance yourself from a false word; do not execute the innocent or the righteous, for I shall not exonerate the wicked. Do not accept a bribe, for the bribe will blind those who see and corrupt words that are just.” (Shemos 23: 7-8)

“HaShem said to Moshe, ‘Ascend to the mountain, and remain there, and I shall give you the stone tablets and the teaching and the commandment that I have written to teach them.’” (Shemos 24:12)

The following are three examples of judges of Israel during the course of Biblical history:

Devorah: We find in Sefer Shophtim a verse describing the role played by Devorah at a crucial point in time: *“And Devorah was a prophetess, the wife of Lapidos; she judged Israel at that time. She would sit under the date palm of Devorah between Ramah and Beth-El on Mt. Ephraim, and the Children of Israel would go up to her for judgment.”*

“She sent and summoned Barak son of Avinoam of Kedesh-Naphtali, and said to him, ‘Behold, Ha-Shem, the G-d of Israel has commanded, ‘Go and take the People to Mt. Tavor...I will draw towards you – Sisera, the general of Yavin’s army, with his chariot and his multitude; and I shall deliver him into your hand.’”

“Barak said to her, ‘If you will go with me, I will go; but if you will not go with me, I will not go.’ She said, ‘Indeed, I will go with you – but the path on which you have chosen to go will not bring you glory, for HaShem will have delivered Sisera into the hands of a woman’ ” (Shophtim 4:4-9) We see from this the relative frailty of the men of Israel and the bravery of the women in her time. In her immortal song, she praised Yael, *“Blessed of women is Yael...by women in the tent shall she be blessed.”* (Shophtim 5:24)

Shmuel: *“Shmuel judged Israel all the days of his life. He would travel year after year, circling to Beth-El, Gilgal, and Mizpah, and judging Israel in all these places. Then he would return to Ramah, for his home was there, and there he would judge Israel...”* (Shmuel 1 7:15-17)

Shlomo: *“Then two women, innkeepers, came to the king, and stood before him. One woman said, ‘Please, my lord: I and this woman dwell in one house, and I gave birth while with her in the house. On the third day after I gave birth, this woman gave birth as well. We were together; there was no outsider with us in the house...The son of this woman died at night, because she lay upon him. She arose during the night and took my son from my side while your maidservant was asleep, and laid him in her bosom. When I arose in the morning to nurse my son, behold, he was dead! When I studied him in the morning, behold it was not my son to whom I had given birth.’”*

“But the other woman said, ‘It is not so! My son is the live one, and your son is the dead one!’”

“But this one said, ‘It is not so! Your son is the dead one, and my son is the live one!’”

“The king said, ‘This one claims, ‘This is my son, who is alive, and your son is the dead one,’ and this one claims, ‘It is not so! Your son is the dead one and my son is the live one.’” So the king said, ‘Fetch me a sword!’ and they brought a sword before the king. The king said, ‘Cut the living child in two and give half to one and half to the other.’ The woman whose son was the live one spoke to the king – because her compassion was aroused for her son – and she said, ‘Please, my lord, give her the living newborn, and do not put it to death.’ But the other one said, ‘Neither mine nor yours shall he be. Cut!’”

“The king spoke, ‘Give her (the first one) the living newborn and do not put it to death; she is his mother.’” (Melachim 1 (3:16-27)
